

Poisoning

If the casualty is conscious:

1. Find out what happened.
2. If the lips or mouth are burning, give sips of water or milk.
3. Place him or her in the recovery positions.
4. Keep the casualty warm and quiet.
5. Keep checking ABC.
6. Get help.

If consciousness is lost:

7. Open the airway, and if necessary, restore breathing and circulation.

BUT DO NOT CONTAMINATE YOURSELF WITH ANY POISON THAT IS AROUND THE MOUTH.



The casualty must go to hospital immediately.

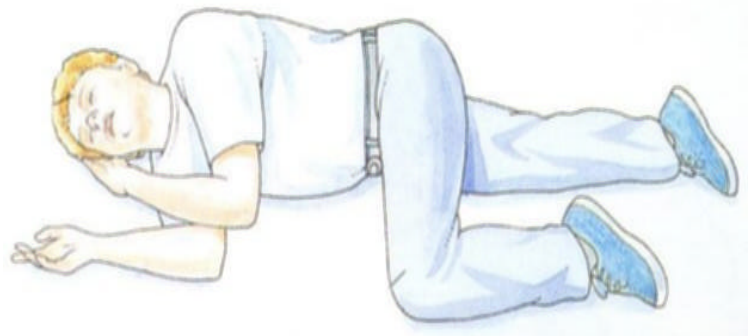
(Pill containers and samples of any vomit should be sent with him or her).

DO NOT MAKE THE CASUALTY VOMIT.

ALCOHOL, DRUG OR SOLVENT ABUSE

As with other forms of poisoning:

1. Find out the facts, what substance is involved?
2. If the casualty is unconscious, check ABC.
3. Place in the recovery position.
4. Keep him or her warm and quiet.
5. Keep checking ABC.
6. Get help immediately.
